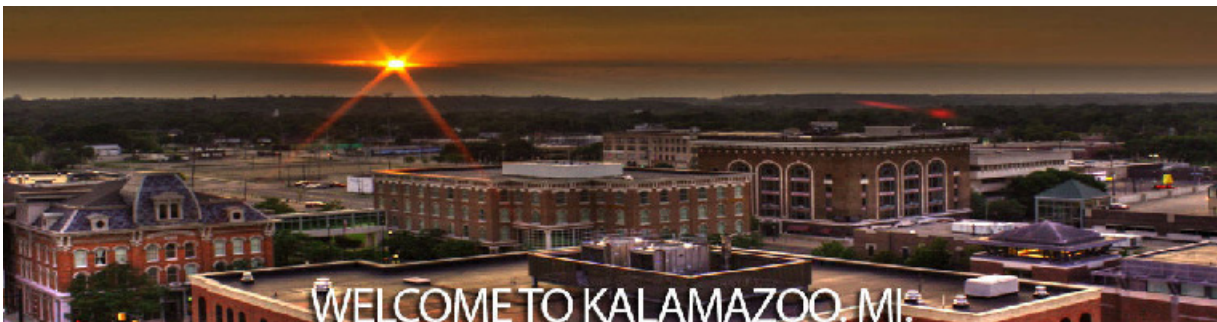
RESERVATIONS
